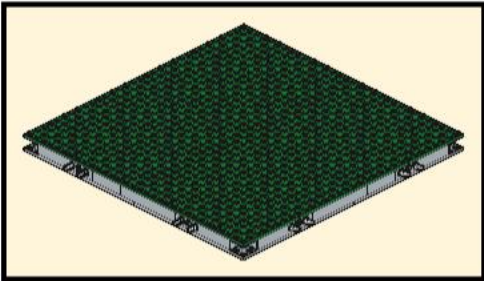
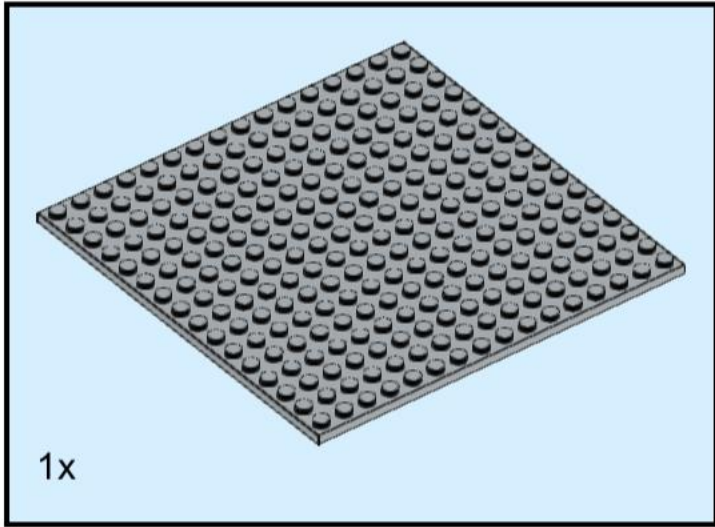
## Optional Identifier

For easy identification of which modules are yours when collecting after a show, it is advised to include a unique pattern of three plates in each corner of your module below ground level as indicated here.

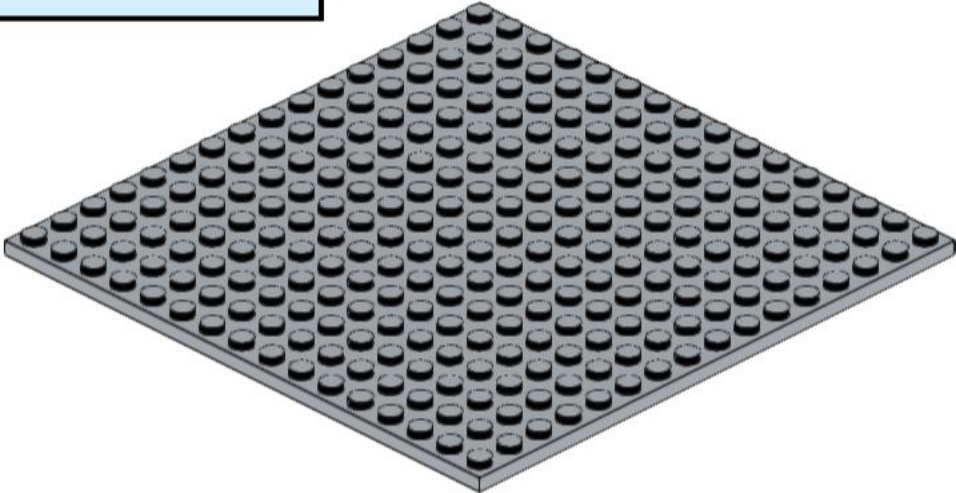
The pattern should be the same on each corner of each module you build. Let us know what pattern you will use before building and we will make a note of it so that we don't get multiple people using the same pattern.



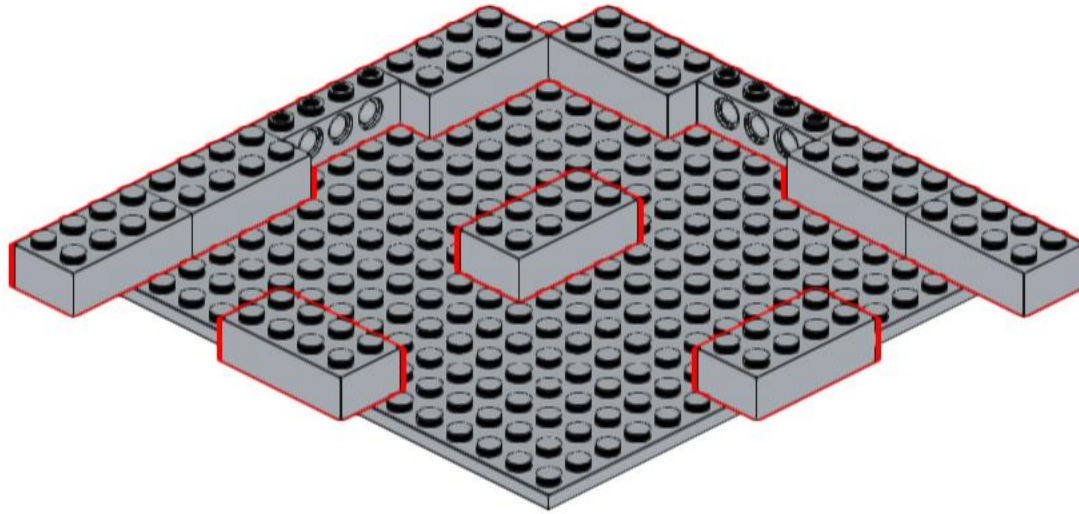
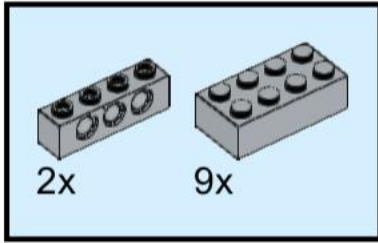

Standard colours to be used for base sections are shown here listed using the Bricklink name [BL] followed by the official LEGO name [TLG]

Standard Base Sections:  
Green [BL] / Dark Green [TLG].



16 x 16 Base Section with Dirt Track:  
8 studs of Dark Tan [BL] / Sand Yellow [TLG] in centre.  
4 studs of Green [BL] / Dark Green [TLG] either side.

16 x 16 Base Section with Cobblestone Road:  
Dark Tan [BL] / Sand Yellow [TLG] plate layer with  
Light Bluish Grey [BL] / Medium Stone Grey [TLG] and  
Dark Bluish Grey [BL] / Dark Stone Grey [TLG] round  
tiles in varying sizes on top.

These instructions are intended to be used as inspiration for your own contributions to the collaborative build. As long as the connecting edges match and you follow the guidelines in the briefing document on the GertLUG website, we welcome variations to build up a large display produced by as many of our members as possible, which will appear at the Bristol Brick Show 2023.
